 - 1. Do you need to give something to God? Is that blessing him
 - 1. Deuteronomy 26 place the fruit in a basket and give it to the Lord
 - 2. Leviticus 27 give 10% of everything to the Lord
 - 3. You aren't making his life better though?
- 2. Why should we bless him
 - 1. He delivers
 - Looking back at Psalm 120 1 In my distress I called to the Lord, and he answered me. 2 "Lord, rescue me from lying lips and a deceitful tongue." 3 What will he give you, and what will he do to you, you deceitful tongue? 4 A warrior's sharp arrows with burning charcoal! 5 What misery that I have stayed in Meshech, that I have lived among the tents of Kedar! 6 I have dwelt too long with those who hate peace. 7 I am for peace; but when I speak, they are for war.

 - 1. He is the one with steadfast and unfailing love
 - 2. He is the one who doesn't sleep or slumber
 - 3. He is the one who clothes us with salvation
 - 4. He is the covenant keeper
 - 5. He the redeemer and it's plentiful!
 - 6. He is the one who gives forgiveness and hears our cry for mercy
 - 7. He is the giver of all God's gifts
 - 8. He is the one who watches, builds, and restores us
 - 9. He is the one who leads
 - 4. Proverbs 16.19 A person's heart plans his way, but the LORD determines his steps."

 - 4. But in Christ the work is done
 - 1. Matthew 26.64 "You have said so," Jesus replied. "But I say to all of you: From now on you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven."
- 3. Because You are part of his Kingdom
 - 1. He has saved you into His Holy Place 1 Peter 2.9 9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
 - 2. Worship Him by lifting your hands
- 3. We praise God for his incredible blessing!
 - 1. The Priestly Blessing from Aaron in Numbers 6 "The Lord bless you and keep you; 25 the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; 26 the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."
 - 2. Do you realize who we call on The Maker of Heaven and Earth
 - 5. This God blesses You!
 - 1. Derek Kidner the exchange is quite unequal to bless God is to acknowledge gratefully what he is; but to bless man God must make of him (man) what he is not and give him (man) what he has not!
 - 2. You have tried and tried and tried desired and desired, but you have wanted the wrong thing
 - 6. And this is the ultimate blessing...
 - 1. CHRIST CAME DOWN and built his temple in you!!!!
 - 2. Ephesians 1.3-6 3 Blessed is the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavens in Christ. 4 For he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and blameless in love before him. 5 He predestined us to be adopted as sons through Jesus Christ for himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace that he lavished on us in the Beloved One.
